**Disruption on Air Mauritius Flights from / to Europe - 8 and 9 December**  
**(ALL TIMES LOCAL)**

A. Due to weather conditions in Europe and closure of Paris Charles de Gaulle airport,

1. Flight MK045 scheduled to depart on 08 December at 16h20 will now depart from Paris as MK3045 on 09 December at 10h00 and reach Mauritius on 10 December at 00h40.
2. Flight MK051 (Air France aircraft) scheduled to depart from Paris on 08 December at 16h10 has been cancelled.

Consequently flight MK040 scheduled to depart from Mauritius on the 09 of December at 08h40 has also been cancelled. Air France and Air Mauritius are working on alternative arrangements and will keep passengers informed during the day.

3. Flight MK036 scheduled to depart to Paris on 09 December at 09h20 will now depart on 09 December at 23h00 and reach Paris on 10 December at 08h00  
Consequently flight MK047 scheduled to depart Paris on 09 December at 20h20 will now depart Paris on 10 December as MK4047 at 10h15 and reach Mauritius on 11 December at 00h55.

B. Flight MK 057 scheduled to depart London on 08<sup>th</sup> December at 20h00 is delayed due to a technical problem. We are locating the required spare parts and the aircraft will depart after the necessary repairs in London. A further communications will be issued in the afternoon.

Air Mauritius apologies for all these unavoidable delays and is working with the airport authorities in Paris to minimize inconvenience to passengers in these exceptional circumstances. In London, passengers have been provided accommodation at the Gatwick Copthorne hotel as there was no accommodation available in the Heathrow area.

**Air Mauritius also wishes to reaffirm that the safety of all its passengers and crew remain its topmost priority.**
