Climatic conditions in Europe continue to cause major disruptions to flight schedules

Severe weather conditions continue to cause significant disruptions to our operations.

Unfortunately London Heathrow and Paris Charles de Gaulle remain closed except for a handful of flights (mostly departing flights).

We are following the situation closely with the airport authorities and will schedule flights as soon as airports open and slots become available for our operations.

1. Flight MK045/20 Dec Paris-Mauritius is delayed until further notice.
2. Flight MK034/20 Dec Mauritius-Paris is delayed until further notice.

Following approval of slots by the UK Authorities, we are now planning to operate

MK 6046 from Milan to London Heathrow this afternoon at 17h30 with passengers of MK 046/18 December (stuck in Milan since Saturday night). Flight scheduled to arrive London at 18h15

MK 6057 from London to Mauritius this evening at 20h00 with passengers booked on MK 057/18 December. Flight is expected to land in Mauritius on 21 December at 11h55.
