**Air Mauritius to Increase Fuel Surcharge for the first time in more than two years.**

Air Mauritius will increase its fuel surcharge for tickets issued on or after 01 February 2011 as a result of the sustained escalation in the price of fuel.

The new levels represent an increase of between **2 Euros** and **15 Euros** per sector.

Air Mauritius last increased the fuel surcharge in July 2008. It has been reduced twice since then. The airline will continue to monitor the price of fuel and keep surcharges under constant review.
